PRAY! Pray for the wisdom you need to deal with the things that God has placed before you. He truly is our best source of wisdom and should be our first.

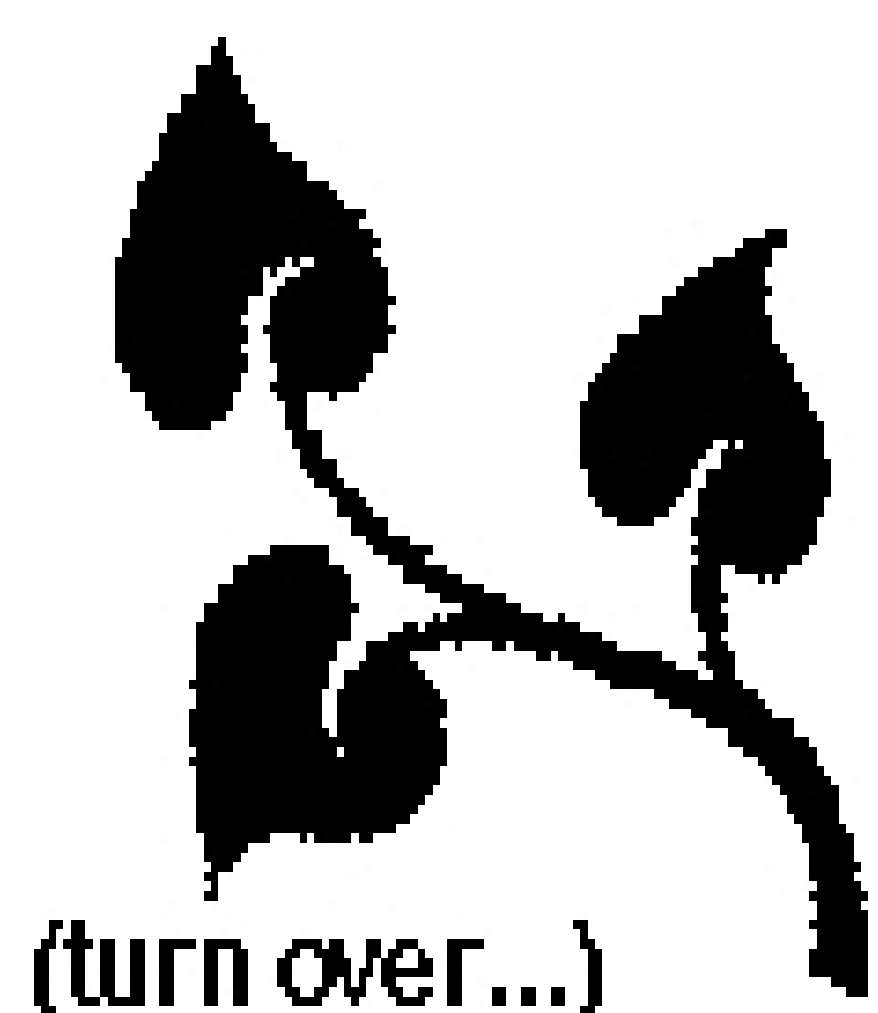


GROW! Read Prov. 1: 1-7, I Kings 3 & 4, Psalms 78:2, Job 28:28, & James 1:5.

1. **JUST FOR FUN!** Have you ever played a game of horseshoes, croquet, or darts? What did you enjoy most about it? Instead of tv or xbox this week, take time to teach the next generation these classic games!
2. What nation did Solomon rule as king and whose son was he? (Prov. 1:1)
3. Why would Solomon be considered more qualified than any other man to contribute to the Book of Proverbs? (I Kings 3:5-12)



4. According to I Kings 4:32, how many proverbs did Solomon speak?

5. Read I Kings 3:28. What did the nation of Israel see that was in Solomon and how did they respond to him.

6. What does Job 28:28 say wisdom *is*? And what *is* understanding?
