PRAY! Pray that God will bring His Word alive to you in a way that you can understand it and apply it to all the circumstances in your life.

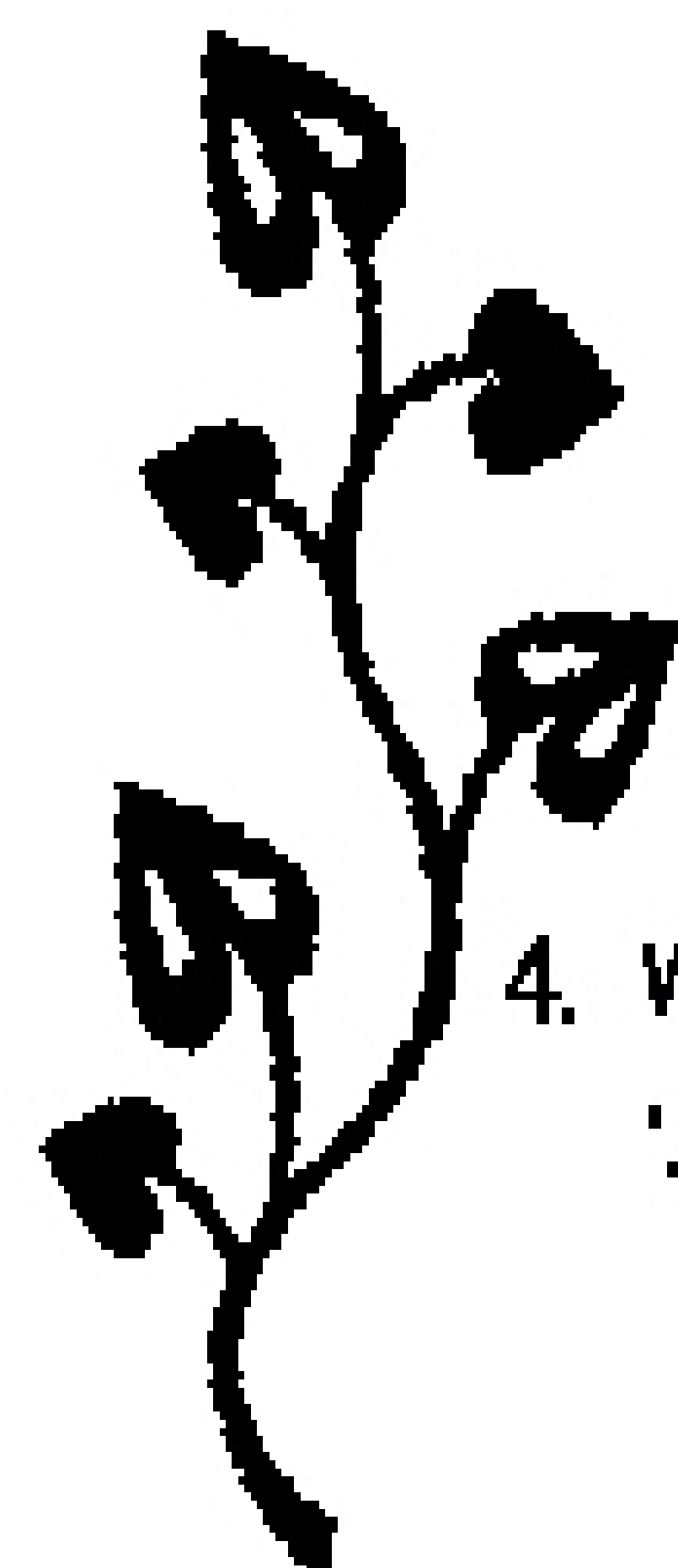

2. According to Deut. 8:1, what are we to be very careful about so that we might receive the promises of God?

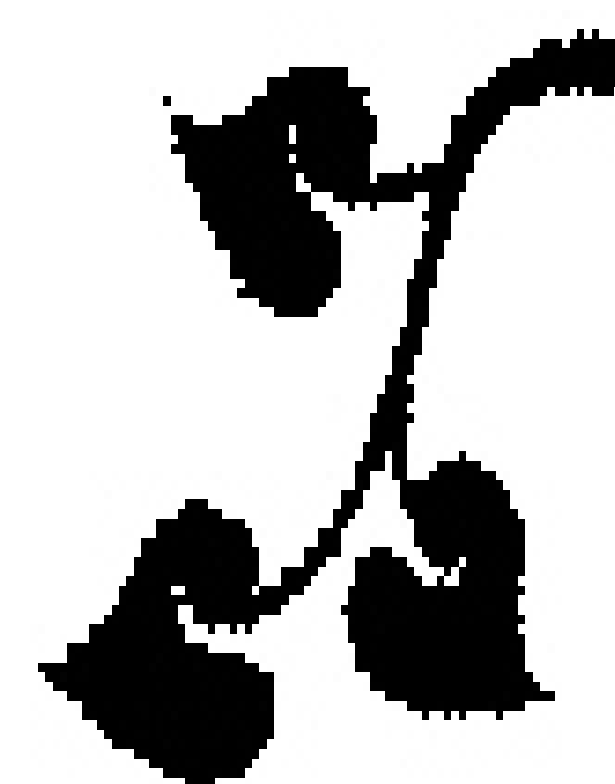
3. What will God not withhold from those who walk uprightly before Him? (Psalm 84:11)

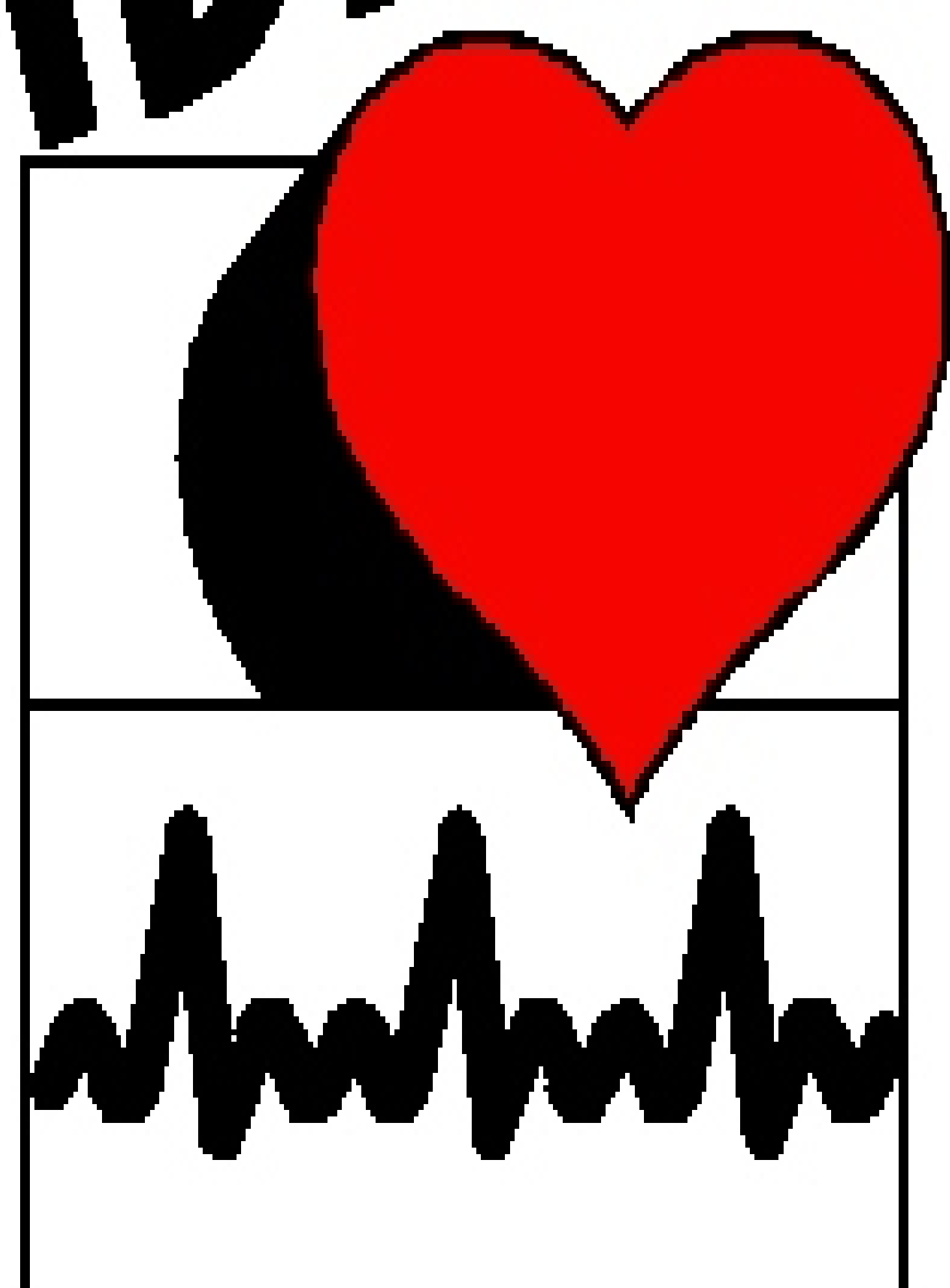


5. What happens to those who turn aside to their own crooked ways? (Psalm 125:5)
