GROW! Proverbs 10-15, Leviticus 19:35-36, Psalm 1:1 and Revelation 22:14-15.

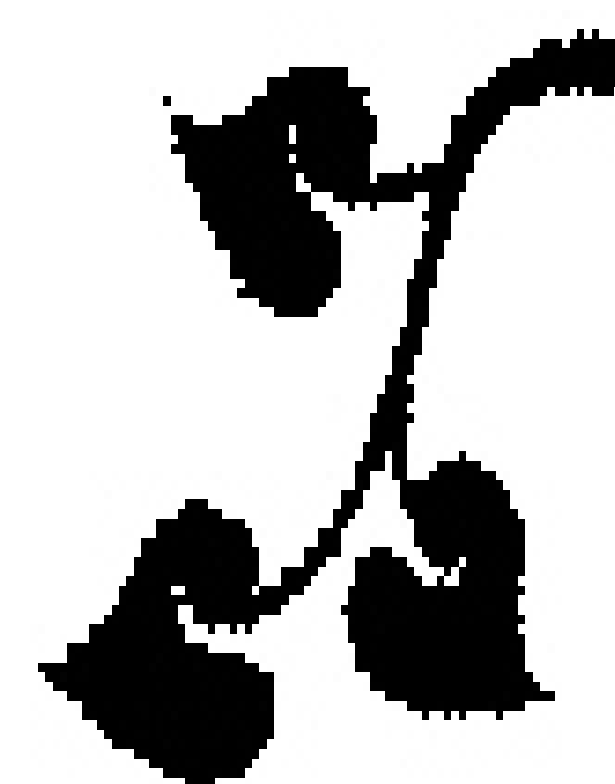
1. **JUST FOR FUN!** Describe yourself in one word. Now ask your friend to describe you in one word. Was it a close match?

6. Proverbs 11:14 says that '...in the multitude of counselors there is safety.' What type of people should you NOT seek counsel from? (Psalm 1:1)
7. Upon Christ's return, where will liars be found? Who will be there with them? (Rev. 22:14-15)

Draw your own 'THIS' or 'THAT' example. Think of a character trait that you want to see more of in your life (THIS). Draw it. Flip the paper over and draw it's opposite (THAT). Now find a verse that will help you develop your 'THIS' on a daily basis.
