## Week 6 - Are You a Wise Guy?

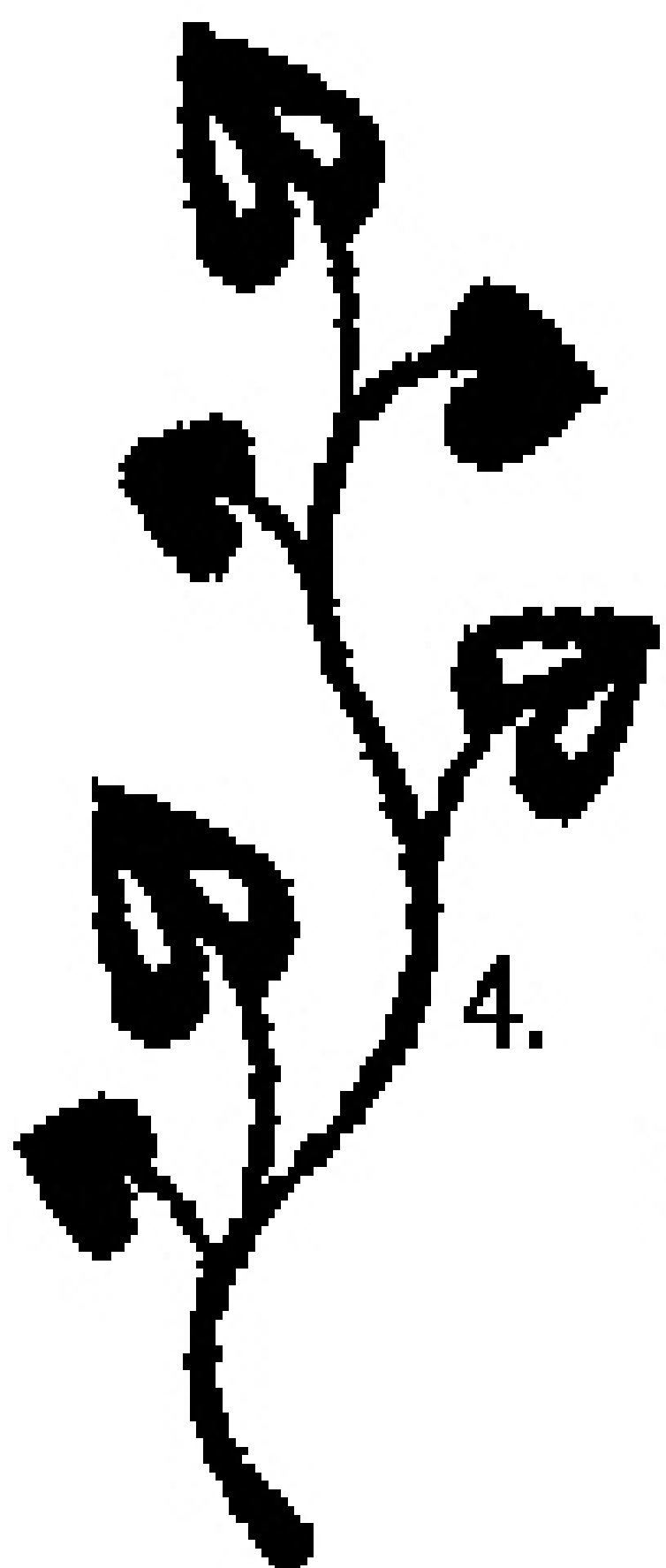
### PRAY!

### GROW!

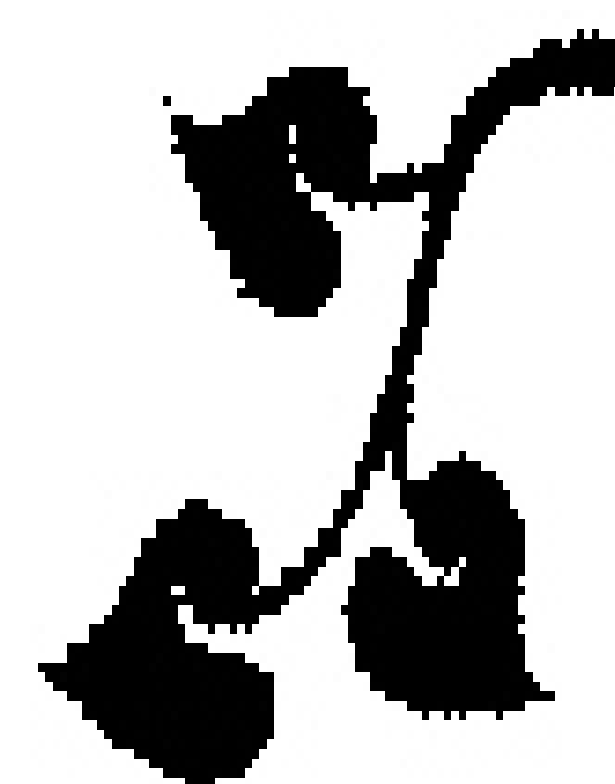
Read Proverbs 29-30 for personal study. For questions below read Proverbs 29:18; Jonah 1-4, Acts 11:1-18, Deuteronomy 30:10-20).

1. JUST FOR FUN! Can you name five different colors that leaves turn in the Fall?
2. Proverbs 29:18 says that “where there is no revelation (understanding of God's principles), the people cast off restraint (perish)”; but when people keep and obey God's laws (principles), they are \_\_\_\_\_. Give an example of when you witnessed this truth in your life or in someone you know.
3. Read the Book of Jonah (4 chapters). List some of the consequences Jonah experienced when he did not obey God.



4. When Jonah realized that “salvation is of the Lord” (2:9) and is finally willing to obey God, what did God do? (v.10)

5. What was the result of Jonah 'wising up' and obeying God? (v. 3:10)
6. The vision or revelation of God always transforms human life. How did Peter's vision help in transforming the lives of the Gentiles? (Acts 11:1-18)
7. In Deuteronomy 30:10-20, the Israelites were admonished to obey the voice of the Lord and to keep His commandments and statutes. What are the results of doing this? (v. 16)

Imagine living just one day with no instruction, guidance or principle to follow or obey. Describe what that day would look like in your life.
